Evaluation of Landscape Potentials of Attouda Ancient City - Hisar Settlement in Frame of Tourism Opportunities

*Multilayered settlements with traces of different civilizations in the historical process face the risk of extinction due to physical, social, economic problems. At this point, the settlements are forced to live with the culture what can be done should be discussed with regards to place, history, geography, socio-economic status, traditional original architectural texture, protection and sustainability of natural and cultural values. "Safeguarding of keeping alive" is a tool to ensure the sustainability of the historical, cultural, environmental and economic with the new function. However, a correct balance between protection and functional change needs to be established. In this study, of cultural and natural environment, social, shaped by the cultural and economic life, the past with the original spatial characteristics of the remaining legacy today, the ancient city of Attouda in archaeological and urban sites feature - Hisar settlement is discussed. In this context of research, it is thought that the suggestions of the landscape potential for the preservation and transfer of the multi-layered cultural landscape to future generations will contribute to the utilization of tourism by considering the balance of protection-use.
